

Brief Test Installation Instructions *OrgPublisher for SAP solutions*

You can find the detailed **installation description** in the directory “[*Your directory*]\orgpubX\SAP”.

Downloading the test version and installation on a local PC

Download the “**OrgPublisher for SAP solutions**” software from Accenture HCMS’ download page: <http://www.ehr-solutions.de/>

Save the .exe file to your local PC (approx. 40 MB).

Install the “OrgPublisher” application on your local PC

You need local administrator rights to do this.

Start the .exe file. Executing the .exe file starts the OrgPublisher setup on a local PC. During setup you can choose the directory where OrgPublisher should be installed, such as: C:\Programs\OrgPubX (X = version number).

After installation, you can start OrgPublisher on a local PC as a local application.

The subdirectory “[*Your directory*]\orgpubX\SAMPLES” contains sample diagrams. The ocb-file contains the data and can be read with a text editor as well; the otm-file contains the layout and formatting.

Import the transport files into SAP

On the local PC on which OrgPublisher was installed, another subdirectory is created: “[*Your directory*]\orgpubX\SAP”. This directory contains the transport files for SAP and the documentation. Send these transport files and the installation description to your SAP administrator to be imported into your SAP system.

The **Installation Description** describes the sequence of the transports, the list of transports and all details about the installation. Your SAP administrator should read this file beforehand.

Once these files have been imported, use the ABAP Workbench (Transaction SE38) to start report /EHR/SOL71_CUST, so that the customizing entries from client 000 are copied to the work client.

After the upload, the EHR-SOLUTION:_ORGPUBLISHER role with the following transactions is available:

/EHR/SOL71_ORGPUB = Interface for the download
/EHR/SOL71_WZ_FORMAT = Wizard for output formats
/EHR/SOL71_IMG = Maintenance transaction for customizing the interface

As a user, you need the right to execute all programs/objects/EHR/*.

Activate the interface

The interface activates itself automatically for 30 days after the initial installation. If the automatic activation was not successful or if you want to spend more time testing, call Transaction /EHR/SOL71_ORGPUB and then click on "License". Email the product key that is specified here to hcmsoftwareregistration@accenture.com . You can also send the key to the registration@acquire.com address specified. We advise you to use the first address to avoid delays caused by different time zones.

Start download


Version 1: Start OrgPublisher using PPOME

- Call Transaction PPOME
- Choose "Goto" → "Change View" to change the "Staff Assignments (Structure)"
- Select a root object (double-click an organizational unit)
- Click on "Format Structure Graphically"
- OrgPublisher starts with the chart. It is black and white the first time it is called. Adapt the colors and save the formatting in OrgPublisher by choosing "File" → "Set template as default".


Version 2: Start OrgPublisher locally

Use F4-Help for the inputs and F1-Help for the online documentation.

- Call Transaction /EHR/SOL71_ORGPUB
- Set the parameter for the root object (plan variant, object type, ID) and select the evaluation period



- Choose an output format, such as "/EHR/MIN" or "/EHR/MAX"
- *Optional:* choose the related template (*_DE for German, *_EN for English)



- Choose "On local workstation" and specify a file path for the output file, such as: C:\temp\test.ocb
- Choose "Call OrgPublisher application" and "None" custom fields, if you are using a template
"all (custom fields) with field labels" if you are not using a template.
- *Optional:* Create variants of the transaction for each output format.

Execute the download by pressing **F8 / Execute**.

Create your own output formats using wizards

Start with the "Wizard for output formats". This transaction is already available in the role or you can start the wizard within the /EHR/SOL71_IMG. To create your own output format, we recommend copying one of the standard output formats and adding or deleting output fields from the copy.

This allows you to create your first output format within minutes. Use the remaining wizards to extend this output format, e.g. with additional **position types, your own output fields, or filter** for the download of HR data.

All wizards are documented online and very easy to use. Use the F4-help whenever possible. You will be guided step by step. In the final step customizing tables will be generated. Intermediately, you can check the customizing tables.

Only if you have more complex requirements such as IF-statements or if you want to insert user exits, you have to customize the tables manually.

Go to transaction /EHR/SOL71_ORGPUB and start the download (F8) with your output format, no template, "all custom fields with field labels", and save to a new file name.

Test publishing to a Web server

Create a publishing definition in OrgPublisher

In OrgPublisher, choose "File" → "Publish" → "New" and create a "Publishing Definition". You can copy and link the output directly to a Web server.
